Michigan PTA Centennial Recognition Program Guidelines

Eligibility for Recognition

To be eligible for the Recognition Program, Units and Councils must satisfy Standards of Affiliation. The prerequisites are:

- *Register officer names and contact information with state office*
- *Remit annual unit dues (currently \$40)*
- *Remit membership dues to the state office by the 28th of each month (local units only)*
- *Submit a copy of the approved annual budget, audit, and Form 990 to the state office upon completion but not later than December 1st*
- *Submit names and dues of members*
- *Review/revise bylaws every three (3) years and submit a copy along with the minutes from the meeting in which members adopted them to the state office for approval*
- *Submit a copy of current Insurance coverage*

Distinctions between Certificates and Awards

***Certificates** are awarded based on information from the Field Service Reports (FSRs)/records. Units and Councils should make sure that all membership data is sent to the Office on a regular basis by the 28th of each month. Certificates are non-competitive.*

***Awards** are competitive and are judged independently by the Awards Committee (sometimes Awards are judged by other states). Not every award is required to be given, even if there are applicants. This category is designed to showcase the efforts of our units and councils, not to award participation/recognize nominees.*

Certificate of Achievement

The Certificate of Achievement is issued to those units who meet the eligibility requirements for recognition and have obtained the goal membership for the year by the April 15th deadline. Only information submitted properly to the state office by the deadline qualifies for consideration.
